Right of Inurnment for a Columbarium Niche

THIS RIGHT OF INURNMENT, contract made and entered into this ____ day of _____, by and between St. Mary Magdalene Catholic Church, Apex, North Carolina, hereinafter referred to as the "Church," and _____, hereinafter referred to as "Purchaser".

WHEREAS, the Church has set aside a plot of land known as the St. Mary Magdalene Catholic Church Columbarium, for the inurnment of the cremated remains of members of the Church and their families, and

WHEREAS, the Church has established a set of policies governing eligibility and use of the Columbarium, and the Purchaser has received a copy and is familiar with the content thereof, and the said guidelines are incorporated as if fully set out herein, and Purchaser agrees to future changes in said guidelines that may be made by the Church.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of \$_____ paid to the Church by Purchaser, the parties covenant and agree with the other as follows:

1. The Church agrees to provide to Purchaser a niche in the columbarium for the cremated remains of Person, to have the niche inscribed with the name and date(s) of birth & death and to provide perpetual care. If not named below, the second occupant will be named at a later time by Purchaser (or the executor of Purchaser's estate) by amending this document.

Below is the information provided during your reservation process. Your signature on this document confirms that the information below is correct, including the order in which the name(s) will be engraved on the niche faceplate.

2. The Church, as beneficial owner, shall retain title to said property and grants hereby to Purchaser the right to the use of the Columbarium Niche in accordance with the guidelines and regulations referred to above.
3. Purchaser authorizes the Church to relocate the columbarium or cremated remains to another proper location should it become necessary for any reason, and this authorization shall be binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns of the Purchaser.
4. Purchaser warrants a property right in and to the mortal remains of the person or persons anticipated to be interred and further warrants authority to execute to this agreement. The Church assumes no responsibility to inquire further into the authority of the person executing this contract.
