PASTOR'S PARAGRAPH

My Dear Friends,



This week is Catholic Schools Week. We wish a happy week to all our students, parents, and teaching staff. This Spring we will graduate our 19th class. The old Yearbooks show how they looked back in our beginning.

Today we begin the Bishop's Annual Appeal. I have found the parish most responsive to the routine we had used for quite a few years. At the beginning of the sermon ushers will pass out pledged forms which can later be placed in the collection. Our goal this year is \$191,507. Doing the math – to meet our goal we ask a pledge of \$187 from each parish household.

We have received \$10,650 from 39 households. This year reporting will be delayed because of extra security precautions the diocese is taking with your donations.

This week also there will be a 2nd Collection. This is an annual collection for the church in Latin America.

CONFESSIONS: There will be Confessions Saturday January 26, after Baptisms and on Saturday February 2.

Baptisms are welcome at the Easter Sunday Masses.**

OUR NEW CHURCH – We have the obligation to make large monthly payments for 14 years for the construction of the church. In addition we are challenged to respond to new parish endeavors in all our parish programs. We are grateful to those who help us in the weekly Offertory for regular expenses and in the monthly white envelope for debt payments for the church.



Catechetical Corner

Inclement Weather Policy - As stated on the parish website religious education page as well as on the class session calendar, the elementary program does **NOT** follow the decisions made by the Wake County school system or StMM Catholic School. Decisions are made by the program coordinator. Once the decision is made to close the elementary programs we notify WRAL with a posting. If you don't see StMM on the band running across the bottom of the television than it is safe to conclude that we are in session. When available we will also post it on the parish site as well as send an email to all registered program families.

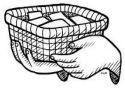
