Please consider a pledge of \$187 over a six month period. \$32 per month – the Diocese will send you a reminder each month.


During Lent our Deacons will lead Stations of the Cross on Fridays at 7 pm in the Church

Catechetical Corner

Thank You to all our 3rd grade families for their toilet paper contributions for **Catholic Parish Outreach**.

Grade 4 Program Families – You week for donations is March 18th/20th/21st. Please leave your contributions in the lobby of the Education Building before or after class. Please be as generous as your means will allow. Thank you in advance for your support for the poor of Wake County.

All Program Families – Last week rice bowls for Catholic Relief Services were distributed after all our class sessions. Rice Bowl contributions are a great way for a family to participate in almsgiving during the season of Lent. If you'd like a rice bowl, see Celeste in the parish office. Contributions are due back the week of March 18th.

Our Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Program is a Montessori based catechetical program offered in levels of mixed grade groups. Each session is capped at 10 students/class. Students must be age appropriate by August 31st. Level I for 3's/ PK/K is offered on Sundays from 8:45a-10a OR 10:30-11:45. Level II for grades 1/2/3 is offered on Sundays from 12p-1:15p as well as Tuesdays from 5p-6:15p. Level III for grades 4/5 is offered on Wednesdays from 5p-6:15p. Level II is required for Level III. Sessions take place in the Atrium (old chapel) in the Activities Building. Program runs from late September through late April/early May depending on the Feast of Pentecost each liturgical year. Registration opens in June & runs through August 31st each year. To find out more about this second religious education program please visit www.stmm.church. Select Religious Education.

First Communion 2018 Parent Meetings are set for Monday, February 19th OR February 20th at either 10:30am OR 7pm. All meetings will be held in the Media Center **NOT** the church as previously communicated. One parent attends only one of the 4 meetings. No one is excused from attending even if you have attended in the last 2 years. This is the first set of First Communions in the new worship space so all families need to be informed.

Parish First Communion Dates for 2018 are April 21st/22nd & April 28th/29th at all weekend liturgies.

Parish Families with 1st Graders in 2018-2019!! – First Reconciliation & First Eucharist are typically received in 2nd Grade. It is a two-year preparation. Kindergarten is optional & does not meet sacrament requirements. Grade 1 is required for Grade 2. If your child is starting 1st Grade in 2018-2019 then you need to register for class instruction with the parish in our Traditional Religious Education Elementary Program. A Catholic baptism is required. Updated information will be posted in May, 2018 for the new year. You can still access www.stmm.church. Select Religious Education. Select Elementary, Click on informational links to get a feel for the days & times class sessions are offered. You pick only one session & attend the same session each week.


Search Retreat for 10-12 Graders-Don't miss this opportunity to interact and share your faith with other Catholic teenagers from




