My Dear Friends,

This week we will celebrate 2 Sacraments for young members of our parish.

On this weekend and next there will be 130 children who receive First Communion at the weekend Masses. We congratulate the children, their parents, and those in our Faith Formation program who helped to prepare them for this wonderful day. May the Lord who nourishes them in the Eucharist continue to bless them all their lives. 36 of these children were baptized at St Mary Magdalene.



On Wednesday evening Bishop Luis Rafael Zarama will be with us to confer the Sacrament of Confirmation on 126 students in our Youth Program. Congratulations to the students, their parents, and those in our Youth program who helped in the two year preparation period. We welcome all the family members who have come from out of town to honor those receiving the sacraments. Also one other big event on Sunday evening at our 6 pm Youth Mass -- Bishop Luis Rafael Zarama will make his first visit to our parish to celebrate this Mass. It is a visit to honor our Youth at their last Mass of the year, but all members of the parish are welcome to attend.

Catechetical Corner

Many Thanks to all who volunteered at our First Communion Retreat on April 14.

Traditional Elementary Program Families – Class sessions are now complete for the 2017-2018 catechetical year. Re-registration forms will be made available on www.stmm.church starting in May. Program begins again the week of September 23, 2018.

Last Class Sessions for Catechesis of the Good Shepherd are May 13th/15th/16th. Re-registration forms will also be made available on www.stmm.church starting in May. Program begins again the week of September 23, 2018.

Our Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Program is a Montessori based catechetical program offered in levels of mixed grade groups. Each session is capped at 10 students/class. Students must be age appropriate by Aug. 31st. Level I for 3's/PK/K is offered on Sun. from 8:45-10am OR 10:30-11:45am. Level II for grades 1/2/3 is offered on Sun. from 12-1:15pm as well as Tues. from 5-6:15pm. Level III for grades 4/5 is offered on Wed. from 5-6:15pm. Level II is required for Level III. Sessions take place in the Atrium (old chapel) in the Activities Building. Program runs from late Sept. through late April/early May depending on the Feast of Pentecost each liturgical year. Registration opens in June & runs through Aug. 31st each year. For more info about this second religious education program please visit www.stmm.church. Select Religious Education.

Parish Families with 1st Graders in 2018-2019!! – First Reconciliation & First Eucharist are typically received in 2nd Grade. It is a two-year preparation. Kindergarten is optional & does not meet sacrament requirements. Grade 1 is required for Grade 2. If your child is starting 1st Grade in 2018-2019 then you need to register for class instruction with the parish in our Traditional Religious Education Elementary Program. A Catholic baptism is required. Updated information will be posted in May, 2018 for the new year. You can still access www.stmm.church. Select Religious Education. Select Elementary, Click on informational links to get a feel for the days & times class sessions are offered. You pick only one session & attend the same session each week.

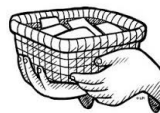
