

We had a very fine Happy 1st Anniversary party last weekend. Many thanks to the Parish Council members who coordinated the event.



2018-2019 Elementary Program Registration for Returning Families & New Families will be available on <a href="www.stmm.church">www.stmm.church</a> the week of May 20th. Registration will run until Aug. 31st. Our programs begin the week of Sept. 23rd. Please note in registering in May & June your instructional materials fee will be held until the new fiscal year begins on July 1, 2018. All forms will be updated on <a href="www.stmm.church">www.stmm.church</a> the week of May 20 as well. To access the religious education page enter <a href="www.stmm.church">www.stmm.church</a> / Select Religious Education / Select Elementary. You will see links to specific information.

Volunteer Catechists are always needed each catechetical year. Joining this ministry is a great way to meet other people. Requirements are minimal. You need to be a baptized Catholic in good standing with the Church. You need to Level C approved in our Safe Environment procedure. You need to be willing to give 75 minutes a week to a specific grade. Please give it some thought. The more volunteers...the smaller the classes...which is a plus for everyone!

Our Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Program is a Montessori based catechetical program offered in levels of mixed grade groups. Each session is capped at 10 students/class. Students must be age appropriate by Aug. 31st. Level I for 3's/ PK/K is offered on Sun. from 8:45-10am OR 10:30-11:45am. Level II for grades 1/2/3 is offered on Sun. from 12-1:15pm as well as Tues. from 5-6:15pm. Level III for grades 4/5 is offered on Wed. from 5-6:15pm. Level II is required for Level III. Sessions take place in the Atrium (old chapel) in the Activities Building. Program runs from late Sept. through late April/early May depending on the Feast of Pentecost each liturgical year. Registration opens in June & runs through Aug. 31st each year. For more info about this second religious education program please visit <a href="https://www.stmm.church">www.stmm.church</a>. Parish Families with 1st Graders in 2018-2019!! – First Reconciliation & First Eucharist are typically received in 2nd Grade. It is a two-year preparation. Kindergarten is optional & does not meet sacrament requirements. Grade 1 is required for Grade 2. If your child is starting 1st Grade in 2018-2019 then you need to register for class instruction with the parish in our Traditional Rel. Ed Elementary Program. A Catholic baptism is required. At the weekend liturgies, FIOMES OF HOPE July 21-22, StMM will have the opportunity to hear about the work being done

by the heroic Franciscan Clarist sisters among the poorest of the poor in India. It is work that can only be realized through the generosity of laypeople like us. We will learn of the critical need for a new orphanage at Alphonsa Home in Bongaigaon, Assam, India. The sisters are praying to build a home for 75 orphaned and disabled girls who are now crammed into classrooms, as there is no other place for them. The girls have lived in terrible poverty and have been marginalized by society. But now in the loving care of the Franciscan Clarist sisters, they will have a safe, stable life. They will go to school; they will receive proper medication, treatment, and nutritious food. Each \$3,000 we raise will be memorialized with the name of our parish on a stepping stone that will lead to the new building in Bongaigaon.
