

# Reflection

INFO FROM A NEWSLETTER OF WESTERN WAKE CRISIS MINISTRY

- ·Here in Wake County 44% of renters (56,066 households), have difficulty affording their homes;
- •49,000 low-income households spend between 30% and 50% of their income on housing, and are considered housing cost-burdened;
- ·A two-bedroom apartment in Apex averages \$1,158 a month, but the average renter can only afford \$817 a month;
- •In 2015, Wake County had an unmet housing need of ~56,000 affordable units;
- •In 2016, 15,668 Wake County families faced eviction.

The issue of affordable housing (also known as workforce housing) hits close to home at Western Wake Crisis Ministry as we see more and more people walk through our doors seeking financial help, or needing food. These include working families and elderly citizens of Apex having difficulty affording increasing expenses.

As we work toward developing more sustainable solutions for those we serve, access to housing that is affordable needs to be - and will be - an important part of our conversation. This month, we're starting with a call to those in our community who have property they would like to rent at an affordable rate. We invite landlords (especially private landlords) to partner with us in establishing the HOME Project. 


Food is a necessity for us all; some people do not have enough; some people do not receive the best kind of food. Another need people have is a place to live.

2018-2019 Elementary Program Registration for Returning Families & New Families will be available on <a href="www.stmm.church">www.stmm.church</a> the week of May 20th. Registration will run until Aug. 31st. Our programs begin the week of Sept. 23rd. Please note in registering in May & June your instructional materials fee will be held until the new fiscal year begins on July 1, 2018. All forms will be updated on <a href="www.stmm.church">www.stmm.church</a> the week of May 20 as well. Volunteer Catechists are always needed each catechetical year. Joining this ministry is a great way to meet other people. Requirements are minimal. You need to be a baptized Catholic in good standing with the Church. You need to Level C approved in our Safe Environment procedure. You need to be willing to give 75 minutes a week to a specific grade. Please give it some thought. The more volunteers...the smaller the classes...which is a plus for everyone!

Our Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Program is a Montessori based catechetical program offered in levels of mixed grade groups. Each session is capped at 10 students/class. Students must be age appropriate by Aug. 31st. Level I for 3's/ PK/K is offered on Sun. from 8:45-10am OR 10:30-11:45am. Level II for grades 1/2/3 is offered on Sun. from 12-1:15pm as well as Tues. from 5-6:15pm. Level III for grades 4/5 is offered on Wed. from 5-6:15pm. Level II is required for Level III. Sessions take place in the Atrium (old chapel) in the Activities Building. Program runs from late Sept. through late April/early May depending on the Feast of Pentecost each liturgical year. Registration opens in June & runs through Aug. 31st each year. For more info about this second religious education program please visit <a href="https://www.stmm.church">www.stmm.church</a>. Parish Families with 1st Graders in 2018-2019!! – First Reconciliation & First Eucharist are typically received in 2nd Grade. It is a two-year preparation. Kindergarten is optional & does not meet sacrament requirements. Grade 1 is required for Grade 2. If your child is starting 1st Grade in 2018-2019 then you need to register for class instruction with the parish in our Traditional Rel. Ed Elementary Program. A Catholic baptism is required. Select Elementary, Click on informational links to get a feel for the days & times class sessions are offered. You pick only one session & attend the same session each week.



There will be many St. Mary Magdalene Stepping Stones at our newest orphanage in Assam, India.

Well, folks....you certainly outdid yourself! When all the donations are totaled, you have given almost \$10,000 for the construction of Alphonsa Home, the Homes of Hope orphanage that will lovingly care for girls who were orphaned or abandoned, others who are handicapped, autistic, or otherwise marginalized. (And the donations are still coming in.)

That means the girls will be saying their prayers for you each night, walking the Stepping Stones. <u>Three of those stones will be your</u>s. All of you gave generously and a few of you went beyond even that, individually contributing a Stepping Stone.

The sisters really didn't have a proper building for them, so the girls are now crammed into classrooms, as there is no other place for them. But construction has already started, because of you, and in not too many months our 70 girls will have real beds to sleep in, a real dining room, computers to prepare them for life, a dispensary to keep them healthy.






