Reflection

ELIJAH

Elijah joins us for today's liturgy because of his connection to God's gifts of bread that sustain the prophets and people of God. This part of his history, like some of his other wondrous experiences (2 Kings 4:42-44 and 1 Kings 17:9-24), are part of the lore of how God cares for the poor and needy.

We are given such stories not simply because they are great adventures, but because they provide the clues that help us recognize God's action in history. They indicate the kind of things God is known to do. These stories are part of the collective memory that Jesus wanted the Jews to ponder as they questioned whether or not he was of God.

Elijah's miserable moment under the broom bush comes as a key part of his saga.



I will introduce Tyler at the weekend Masses and we wish him God's blessing as he begins studies at St Charles Seminary in Philadelphia.



2018-2019 Elementary Program Registration for Returning Families & New Families will be available on www.stmm.church the week of May 20th. Registration will run until Aug. 31st. Our programs begin the week of Sept. 23rd. Please note in registering in May & June your instructional materials fee will be held until the new fiscal year begins on July 1, 2018. All forms will be updated on www.stmm.church the week of May 20 as well. To access the religious education page enter www.stmm.church / Select Religious Education / Select Elementary. You will see links to specific information.

Volunteer Catechists are always needed each catechetical year. Joining this ministry is a great way to meet other people. Requirements are minimal. You need to be a baptized Catholic in good standing with the Church. You need to Level C approved in our Safe Environment procedure. You need to be willing to give 75 minutes a week to a specific grade. Please give it some thought. The more volunteers...the smaller the classes...which is a plus for everyone!

Our Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Program is a Montessori based catechetical program offered in levels of mixed grade groups. Each session is capped at 10 students/class. Students must be age appropriate by Aug. 31st. Level I for 3's/ PK/K is offered on Sun. from 8:45-10am OR 10:30-11:45am. Level II for grades 1/2/3 is offered on Sun. from 12-1:15pm as well as Tues. from 5-6:15pm. Level III for grades 4/5 is offered on Wed. from 5-6:15pm. Level II is required for Level III. Sessions take place in the Atrium (old chapel) in the Activities Building. Program runs from late Sept. through late April/early May depending on the Feast of Pentecost each liturgical year. Registration opens in June & runs through Aug. 31st each year. For more info about this second religious education program please visit www.stmm.church. Select Religious Education.

Parish Families with 1st Graders in 2018-2019!! – First Reconciliation & First Eucharist are typically received in 2nd Grade. It is a two-year preparation. Kindergarten is optional & does not meet sacrament requirements. Grade 1 is required for Grade 2. If your child is starting 1st Grade in 2018-2019 then you need to register for class instruction with the parish in our Traditional Rel. Ed Elementary Program. A Catholic baptism is required. Updated information will be posted in May 2018 for the new year. Access www.stmm.church. Select Religious Education. Select Elementary, Click on informational links to get a feel for the days & times class sessions are offered. You pick only one session & attend the same session each week.




