REFLECTION

In the Gospel Jesus continues on the road to Jerusalem. He is now about halfway through the journey that He began in chapter 9 of Luke's Gospel.

Along the way Jesus meets Samaritans, women, men, children, Pharisees, scholars, people who are lame, people who suffer from leprosy, people who are blind, a rich official, and tax collectors. To each of these diverse groups, Jesus proclaims the same message: the kingdom of God is at hand. In all that He does Jesus speaks the kingdom and lives the kingdom.

Today's Gospel gives us another vision of what this kingdom is about. The way to enter is 'narrow,' but inside the kingdom we will find people of every race, nation, and tongue.


