PASTOR'S PARAGRAPH


My Dear Friends,

Absent from PREP for Week One? Upon arrival this week into the lobby of the STMM School Building, please stop at the Name Card Table to pick up your child's individual name card with their room number. Take the card to the Catechists and introduce yourself and your child. Room numbers is the 100s are on the first floor. Room numbers in the 200s are on the second floor. On Sundays, classrooms do not open until 12:00 noon and pick up is at 1:15 at your child's classroom. On Wednesdays, classrooms do not open until 6:30 pm and pick up is at 7:45 at your child's classroom.

Building Door Policy Following the children's arrival to PREP classes, the front door of STMM School will be locked until five minutes prior to dismissal. If you wish to enter the building during class time, you will need to ring the security buzzer, located outside the main entrance of the School to the right of the doors labeled with the blue dot and will be buzzed in.

Drop Off Procedures Grades PK-Grade 3 - Drop off & Pick-Up each week is at the classroom. Grades 4 - Drop off & Pick-Up is in the school lobby. Every year we request that no student regardless of age is dropped at curbside. Each family is asked to park their car & walk students inside.
