Reflection

Gerard O'Connell of America magazine reports on final Synod Document

In the final document from the Synod on Young People, the Faith and Vocational Discernment, the synod fathers wrote about the great diversity of situations of young people in a globalized world marked by grave injustices, poverty and violence, as well as the opportunities and the challenges they face in the new digital world. The document also covers the phenomenon of migration, sexuality in the lives of young people, the various kinds of abuses in the church, the role of women in the church, synodality and what it means to build a synodal church, and the importance of discernment in the life of the church and of young people as they seek to find their vocation in life.

The final document was approved on the evening of Oct. 27 by a majority vote. But not everyone was happy with the result, which was released to the press in Italian at the end of the session, together with the voting results. A two-thirds majority (166 votes) was required for its approval, and the text was approved by a vote of 191 (in favor) to 43 (against). The opposition to the text did not come as a complete surprise as many synod fathers were distinctly unhappy that the text was only available to them in Italian, a language not all are fluent in, while others do not want change in the church's approach to some issues.

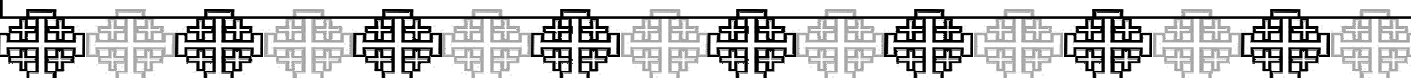
Our parish is grateful for the additional gifts members have made to the offertory and paying for the new church. We have not asked for an increase in offertory since seeking pledges for the new church. But now it is time to ask – the operating costs of the church are larger and we would like to consider our staffing needs as we grow. Our membership has increased by 300 families in the past year.

We received a thank you note from Catholic Charities for the donation of 1,616 pounds of groceries and \$1,815 from the church and 1,302 pounds of groceries from our school. In September Catholic Parish Outreach gave assistance to over 7,400 people.

In the month of November we remember all those who have died. We are grateful for what they have given to us during life and we pray for them eternal rest.

Grade 2 & Wednesday Evening Intermediate Sacrament Program Families - First Reconciliation Parent Meetings are set for Monday, December 3rd & Tuesday December 4th in Church Room 3. Meetings times are 10:30a-12 noon **OR** 7p-8:30p on either day. Only one parent is to attend one meeting. Pick whatever is convenient for your schedule. There is no need to RSVP. Upon arrival you will sign in on the appropriate labeled rosters displayed in the hallway outside Room 3. Please enter the Church behind the Jonah statue on the piazza & not through the main doors. If you attended a First Reconciliation parent meeting in either December 2016 or 2017 you **do not** need to attend, this year. 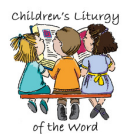

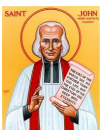
