

The Presentation of the Lord February 2, 2020



Reflection

Malachi came speaking a harsh message and he was not well received. Nevertheless, he persisted in announcing God's Word, as did the prophets before him. This rough-sounding message was necessary if the people were to wake up from their indifference to God's ways. In the middle of the night it is not a gentle summer breeze that wakes us from a deep sleep, but thunder and lightning – enter the prophet Malachi, who sees the people in a spiritual daze and tries to awaken them with verbal fireworks and thunder.

Malachi is the last book in the Old Testament. It doesn't seem like a very gracious way to end the often eloquent message to the Jewish people. When I was a teenager and would oversleep, my mother would come into my room, shake my feet and call my name, in a voice louder than usual, to wake me for school. I would wake startled - a rough way to begin the day - but I wasn't late for school! Malachi's voice was a shout and a warning to wake Israel from its spiritual torpor. The bottom line - his harsh language was a grace, reflecting God's persistent attempts to call us back into God's loving embrace. - Father Jude Siciliano OP



Collection for returning military:

In July of 2019, over 600 soldiers assigned to the 82nd Airborne Division (3rd Brigade, 505th Parachute Infantry Regiment, 2nd Battalion) deployed to Afghanistan to support Operation Enduring Freedom. Approximately 385 of the 600 soldiers were living in barracks at Fort Bragg. In December 2019 the barracks were deemed unlivable and all belongings were moved to storage. These soldiers are returning from Afghanistan in March 2020, to new barracks, but will not have access to their stored belongings for many days. They will be tired, in need of basic toiletries and the ability to wash the limited pieces of clothing that they have on them. Area Scouts are collecting and putting together 385 hygiene kits to be delivered to Fort Bragg and placed on the bed of each returning soldier. We'll be collecting these items at STMM on 2/16/20 before and after all the Masses, PREP, CGS, The EDGE, Apostello, & The Way. If you'd like to help, please donate any of the following items:

- Body Wash
- Shampoo
- Deodorant
- Small Bottle of Water
- 2 Laundry Pods


