


First Sunday Of Lent March 1, 2020



Reflection

Twofold character of Lent: It's clear that Lent is a penitential season. However, that's just half the story. Lent has a twofold character. First, it is a time to recall or prepare for baptism. That is why we celebrate so many of the rites from the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults during Lent. All the baptized assist those preparing to be initiated by "joining the catechumens in reflecting on the value of the paschal mystery and by renewing their own conversion" (RCIA 4). In Lent, we renew our conversion to Christ, particularly through prayer, fasting, and almsgiving.

Recollecting our baptism leads us to the second character of the season. As members of the baptized, we realize that we have not always lived up to our baptismal promises. Our actions and attitudes do not always reflect our faith in the Father, in Jesus, or in the Holy Spirit. Those preparing for baptism may have their moments of doubt as well. For them and for the baptized, penance, especially through more attentive listening to the word of God and fervent prayer, helps us reorient our lives to Christ and dispose us to celebrate his death and resurrection

My Dear Friends,

As we begin Lent and draw closer to Easter the church ceremonies for our RCIA members are more prominent in the weekend Liturgy. This week at the 10:45 Mass we have the Rite of Sending of candidates for baptism to our Bishop. They will join with candidates from all over the Diocese at the Cathedral Sunday afternoon. We in our parish support all the efforts of our RCIA program and the people who have attended classes this year.

Thank you so much for all who sent in their support for our parish BAA this week. We now have received \$181,011 which is 94% or our goal. We have received these gifts/pledges from 554 families, 28% of our 2,119 parish families. We await with great anticipation the response of the remaining 1,568 families.

Keep in mind Almsgiving is part of our practice at Lent. A gift to the BAA is Almsgiving and helps our Diocese and its ministries. All fund over goal come back to our parish.

Norms for Fasting and Abstinence

Ash Wednesday, **February 26, 2020**, and Good Friday, **April 10, 2020**, are days of fasting and abstinence. Fridays of Lent are also days of abstinence.

Fasting is to be observed by all 18 years of age and older, who have not yet celebrated their 59th birthday. On a fast day one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and juices, are allowed.

Abstinence is observed by all 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence, no meat is allowed. Note that when health or ability to work would be seriously affected, Church law does not oblige. When in doubt concerning fast and abstinence, the parish priest should be consulted.

Fasting, almsgiving, and prayer are the three traditional disciplines of Lent. The faithful and Catechumens should undertake these practices seriously in a spirit of penance and of preparation for Initiation into the Church or the renewal of Baptismal Promises at Easter.


