My Dear Friends,

Congratulations and Thanks to Parish Members

We have reached our parish Bishop's Annual Appeal goal. We have received \$222,189 which is 116% of our parish goal. We have received these gifts/pledges from 630 families, 32% of our 2,119 parish families. It would be wonderful to receive a pledge/gift from the remaining 1,489 families – envelopes are in the pews.

On a practical church note -- to minimize transferring a virus, we have stopped using the cup at Communion. Our Communion Ministers purify their hands when they come to the altar. If you prefer not to shake hands at Mass, you may bow to one another. In order to minimize touching another person's mouth, it would be helpful not to receive Communion on the tongue during this crisis.

Thank you for the Ash Wednesday collection for Eastern Europe of \$4,002. And for the USA Missions 2nd collection of \$3,163

Confessions: There will be Confessions on Saturday March 7 at 10:30, after Baptisms; there will also be Confessions on Saturday March 14, at 10:30.

> Norms for Fasting and Abstinence

Ash Wednesday, February 26, 2020, and Good Friday, April 10, 2020, are days of fasting and abstinence. Fridays of Lent are also days of abstinence.

Fasting is to be observed by all 18 years of age and older, who have not yet celebrated their 59th birthday. On a fast day one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and juices, are allowed.

Abstinence is observed by all 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence, no meat is allowed. Note that when health or ability to work would be seriously affected. Church law does not oblige. When in doubt concerning fast and abstinence, the parish priest should be consulted.

Fasting, almsgiving, and prayer are the three traditional disciplines of Lent. The faithful and Catechumens should undertake these practices seriously in a spirit of penance and of preparation for Initiation into the Church or the renewal of Baptismal Promises at Easter.



Voice of the Voiceless: Commemorating Oscar Romero

Duke Divinity School and the Center for Reconciliation with the Fiesta Cristiana congregation in Apex will hold a Concert and Worship Service commemorating the 40th anniversary of Oscar Romero's martyrdom March 22 at 1:30 p.m. at Apex United Methodist Church in Apex, N.C. Romero, the late Salvadoran archbishop who was shot by an assassin as he celebrated mass in a hospital chapel in 1980, was canonized as a saint by Pope Francis in 2018.
