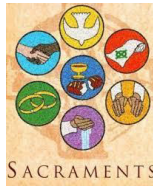
CONFESSIONS: There will not be Confessions on Saturday on January 19. There will be Confessions on Saturday January 26, after Baptisms.

First time parents must attend a baptism class [a good time is during the 9 months prior to birth.] Baptisms are usually, not always, at 10am on Saturdays or at weekend Masses. Baptisms are not encouraged during Lent which begins on March 6 this year. Baptisms are welcome at the Easter Sunday Masses.

CONFESSIONS - Always check the Pastor's Paragraph in the weekly Bulletin or our E-News mailed on Fridays. Confessions are usually, but not every week, at 10:30am on Saturdays in the Church.

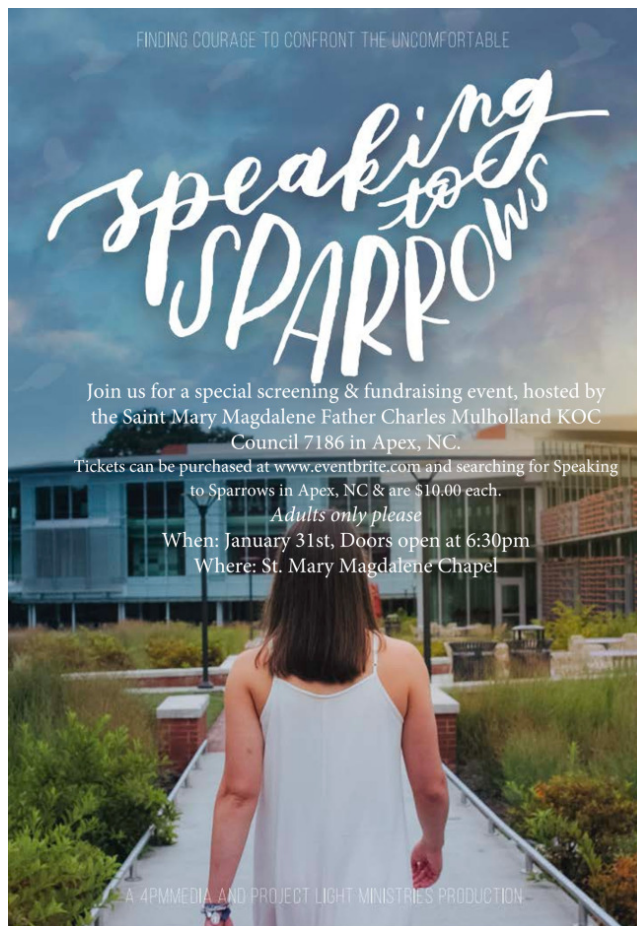
Youth Ministry Haiti Service Project and Haiti Mission Trip Announcement


