BAPTISMS - See the Guidelines on the Website - then email the Pastor. First time parents must attend a baptism class [a good time is during the 9 months prior to birth.] Baptisms are usually, not always, at 10am on Saturdays or at weekend Masses.

CONFESSIONS - Always check the Pastor's Paragraph in the weekly Bulletin or our E-News mailed on Fridays. Confessions are usually, but not every week, at 10:30am on Saturdays in the Church.

WEDDINGS - See the Guidelines on the Website - then email the Pastor.

Homes of Hope India



At the weekend liturgies, July 21-22, StMM will have the opportunity to hear about the work being done by the heroic Franciscan Clarist sisters among the poorest of the poor in India. It is work that can only be realized

through the generosity of laypeople like us. We will learn of the critical need for a new orphanage at Alphonsa Home in Bongaigaon, Assam, India. The sisters are praying to build a home for 75 orphaned and disabled girls who are now crammed into classrooms, as there is no other place for them. The girls have lived in terrible poverty and have been marginalized by society. But now in the loving care of the Franciscan Clarist sisters, they will have a safe, stable life. They will go to school; they will receive proper medication, treatment, and nutritious food. You can find more about the inspired work of the sisters on the website www.homesofhopeindia.org or in the brochure that will be handed out at weekend liturgies. Each \$3,000 we raise will be memorialized with the name of our parish on a stepping stone that will lead to the new building in Bongaigaon.
