
Because of being away and weddings the next time I will be able to have Saturday 10:30 Confessions will be Saturday June 30.

always, at 10am on Saturdays or at weekend Masses.

CONFESSIONS - Always check the Pastor's Paragraph in the weekly Bulletin or our E-News mailed on Fridays. Confessions are usually, but not every week, at 10:30am in the Church.

WEDDINGS - See the Guidelines on the Website - then email the Pastor.

Reflection

Let me close. One of America's most perceptive observers today, David Brooks, worries that the virus of what he calls entitlement might be at epidemic levels: "I got things coming to me.
