Christmas Eve Parking Information

We again have contracted with an outside firm to assist our parishioners attending Christmas Eve Masses with parking on campus. We plan to utilize the ground level parking first and then overflow parking on the upper sports field as needed. The parking contractor will be present from 3pm to 830pm to direct attendees, so please plan to follow their directions. Handicap parking is located in the front of the church (6 spaces) and rear of church (12 spaces), along with drop off under the Portico. There is no lighting on the sports field so please plan accordingly. Current plans are to allow entrance and exiting from both Apex BBQ Road and Townside Drive. We look forward to welcoming everyone for the Masses at 4pm, 7pm and 9pm on Christmas Eve and 10am on Christmas Day.
