# Information About Offertory Envelopes

You will notice a change in the appearance of the offertory envelopes that you receive from our 3rd party supplier. They reported to us in a note this week, that due to both inflationary impacts and supply chain challenges, they will be producing envelopes that may have different appearance in paper and a variety of shades of ink. This is not a permanent change but we wanted to alert you to this in advance.

If you haven't already considered- this might be a great time to convert from these offertory envelopes to our **electronic giving system**. Electronic giving allows for smoother processing, less paper expenses, less time counting and recording envelope giving. We encourage you to consider this instead of offertory envelopes. IF you do change to electronic giving, then the paper envelope delivery can be 'turned off' so you will not receive these anymore therein saving paper and mailing costs.

#### **Outdoor Communion after 9am Sunday Mass only**


There will be two stations available outside in the drive thru at the portico for communion following the 9:00 am Mass for those at-risk and those receiving gluten free hosts.
