Outdoor Communion after 9am Sunday Mass only


There will be two stations available outside in the drive thru at the portico for communion following the 9:00 am Mass for those at-risk and those receiving gluten free hosts.

Adult Confirmation and Catholic Faith Refresher Sessions Forming!!


