#### Outdoor Communion after 9am Sunday Mass


There will be two stations available outside in the drive thru at the portico for communion following the 9:00 am Mass for those at-risk and those receiving gluten free hosts.

# FOOD DRIVE TO SUPPORT HOLLY SPRINGS FOOD CUPBOARD after all Masses 17 – 18 June

The Helping Hands Social Concerns Ministry is sponsoring a food drive to support the Holly Springs Food Cupboard. In one recent week, the Cupboard served 82 families and distributed over 100 student bags. These are families in our community that need help, especially with the cost of food so high and the expiration of Covid benefits. They have empty shelves at the Cupboard, with the supply the lowest they have seen in the last six years.

The cupboard will be happy to receive any nonperishable items. However, we would like this food drive to focus on items for the student bags they provide, such as:

- Granola bars
- fruit cups

- single serving boxes of raisins
- small pop top canned meats (such as vienna sausage, tuna, beanee weenee's)
- juice boxes

#### Monetary donations will also be gratefully accepted.

Items can be dropped off in the Narthex or at the SUV we will have parked outside the church after all Masses during the weekend of June 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>. Thanks so much for your contributions to this effort.

# New Procedures for Taking Holy Communion to the Homebound

Christ has given us the great gift of himself in the Eucharist and one of our greatest blessings is to be able to take Holy Communion to the sick and homebound within our parish. The Diocese of Raleigh has prescribed certain procedures to ensure that the Eucharist is handled with the greatest care and reverence.

If you have been taking the Eucharist to the homebound and would like to continue to do so, please contact Daphne Lobo at <a href="mailto:darlobo@att.net">darlobo@att.net</a> so that you can be StMM trained and approved.

If someone you know only needs Holy Communion for a week or two, please contact Fr. Chris or one of our deacons after Mass for assistance.

If you have a loved one who would like to receive the Eucharist but is unable to attend Mass because of a long-term illness, disability, lengthy recovery from surgery, etc. please contact Daphne Lobo.

From **September 1, 2023**, only approved members of the *StMM Outbound Eucharistic Ministry to the Sick and Homebound* will be given consecrated hosts in the Communion lines to take to homebound parishioners.

Also please pray for Karen and Julie who are continuing their journey.


## RCIA


