Outdoor Communion after 9am Sunday Mass


There will be two stations available outside in the drive thru at the portico for communion following the 9:00 am Mass for those at-risk and those receiving gluten free hosts.

Eucharistic Holy Hour First and Third Tuesdays



The 3rd Tuesday of each month, please join Deacon Rick for Eucharistic Holy Hour and Evening Prayer. This sacred time is an opportunity for a deep, personal encounter with Christ: Pope Francis recommends Eucharistic Adoration as a foundational spiritual practice. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will be followed by evening prayer (Vespers) in the Liturgy of The Hours which represents the official prayers of the Church. We give thanks for the day and praise God. Adoration continues followed by Benediction.

New Procedures for Taking Holy Communion to the Homebound

Christ has given us the great gift of himself in the Eucharist and one of our greatest blessings is to be able to take Holy Communion to the sick and homebound within our parish. The Diocese of Raleigh has prescribed certain procedures to ensure that the Eucharist is handled with the greatest care and reverence.

If you have been taking the Eucharist to the homebound and would like to continue to do so, please contact Daphne Lobo at darlobo@att.net so that you can be StMM trained and approved.

If someone you know only needs Holy Communion for a week or two, please contact Fr. Chris or one of our deacons after Mass for assistance.

If you have a loved one who would like to receive the Eucharist but is unable to attend Mass because of a long-term illness, disability, lengthy recovery from surgery, etc. please contact Daphne Lobo.

From September 1, 2023, only approved members of the StMM Outbound Eucharistic Ministry to the Sick and

Homebound will be given consecrated hosts in the Communion lines to take to homebound parishioners.

Respect Life Corner

June 24th marks the first anniversary of *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization*, which overturned *Roe v Wade.* Most Reverend Michael F. Burbidge, Chairman of the USCCB Committee on Pro-Life Activities released a statement celebrating Dobbs and explaining how the Court's decision marked the beginning of a critical new phase in protecting human life.

"The task before us begins with the knowledge of the truth and our courage to speak it and to live it with compassion," he said, and stated that we are each called to <u>"radical solidarity"</u> with women facing an unexpected or challenging pregnancy and doing whatever we can to provide them with the care and support they need to welcome their children."


