### A Note From Father Donald Staib

Thank you for your generosity to the collection last week for the Archdiocese of Military Services. This is a collection we take every 3 years near to Veterans Day. We received \$5,594 which is very generous for a 2<sup>nd</sup> collection.

Because of the unique collection for Military Services we have another collection again this week. We have the Campaign for Human Development each year near Thanksgiving. These funds are used for self-help projects in our country to serve in needy communities.

When you join with the Catholic Campaign for Human Development, you are helping community development projects led by low income groups to make a difference in their communities. The CCHD works with community groups to find solutions to local problems, to create businesses, and to find ways to improve their lives.

Please keep in your prayers Eamon McCormack, a member of our parish who died this past week.


If you are looking ahead to Thanksgiving - we will have Mass at 10 am that day.

**BAPTISMS** - See the Guidelines on the Website - then email the Pastor. First time parents must attend a baptism class [a good time is during the 9 months prior to birth.] Baptisms are usually, not always, at 10am on Saturdays or at weekend Masses.

**CONFESSIONS** - Always check the Pastor's Paragraph in the weekly Bulletin or our E-News mailed on Fridays. Confessions are usually, but not every week, at 10:30am on Saturdays in the Church.

WEDDINGS - See the Guidelines on the Website - then email the Pastor.

# Reflection

# **Money Matters**

The Pharisee in the Gospel of October 27 gave to the Temple 10% of his income. The Tax collector in the November 3 Gospel gave  $\frac{1}{2}$  of his possessions to the poor. How are we doing at St Mary Magdalene?

Since July 1 2019 our Offertory is about \$10,000 per month short of our budget for 2019-2020. We know some folks choose to give once a year, toward the end of the year. We also hope the 212 new households we have since last January will help us reach our parish needs.

Here is a snapshot of giving patterns since January 2019:

20 families have given between \$6,000 and \$20,000

- 95 families have given between \$3,000 and \$5,999
- 459 families have given between \$1,000 and \$2,999
- 349 families have given between \$500 and \$999
- 474 families have given between \$100 and \$499
- 207 families have given less than \$100
- 433 families have no record of giving

[We have written to most of these 433 families to ask if they are still here and wish to continue to be members of StMM.]

We also have come to realize that some members who made a pledge to the new church will not be completing their pledge. This amounts to \$73,000.

We are so grateful to all who use the White Envelopes; we use these funds to pay our debt for the construction. Blessings to all who help our parish like the Pharisee and the Tax Collector in the Gospels.
