Outdoor Communion after 9am Sunday Mass only


There will be two stations available outside in the drive thru at the portico for communion following the 9:00 am Mass for those at-risk and those receiving gluten free hosts.

We are working with the electrician, designer, and architect for a solution that will get these lights (or replacements) back lighting those areas.




StMM Middle and High School Youth Ministry
