
There will be two stations available outside in the drive thru at the portico for communion following the 9:00 am Mass for those at-risk and those receiving gluten free hosts.

Confirm, Refresh & Renew Your Catholic Faith!


- Are you an adult Catholic who missed Confirmation?Has your faith life felt somewhat dry and routine lately?Do you hunger for a spiritual renewal?
