I received this letter from Bishop Burbidge this past week. We will have a 2nd collection this weekend for the needs of the families in Louisiana. It was sad to see stories of people who thought they were on high ground to suffer from this unique storm.

Bishop Burbidge's Letter

Dear Brother Priests,

In light of the significant damage that has been done from the flooding in Louisiana in recent days, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) has called for a special collection to assist in the disaster relief efforts. We have been informed that as many as 60,000 homes have been damaged, with nearly 20,000 people having been rescued from the flood waters. There are immediate and long-term recovery needs in this region. Many have lost loved ones, and this flooding event has been called the worst domestic natural disaster since Hurricane Sandy.

I ask that you offer your parishioners an opportunity to contribute to this emergency collection on the weekend of September 17/18. The collections should be sent to the Diocesan Business Office, with a notation that they are for 2016 Louisiana Flood Relief. The Diocese will then know the totality of the Diocesan response and will send the funds to the USCCB. This emergency collection will be used to support the humanitarian efforts of Catholic Charities USA and to provide pastoral and rebuilding support to the impacted Dioceses.

I respectfully ask that you offer a special prayer intention at Masses this weekend for all those in need because of the impact from the flooding in Louisiana, as well as for those assisting in the disaster relief efforts.
