A Note From Father Donald Staib

Members of the Parish,

The big work of the moment is clearing the land for the church and for parking. It is sad to cut down trees, and we will replace as many as possible. Would not it be nice to have a 3-4 deck parking place so we did not have to remove trees that have been growing there for many years? I heard that parking decks cost \$10,000 per car. That is way beyond our capability.

I do not know when the GPS systems will adapt to a change in road names. Many people have tried to find Apostle Drive, which was the name of the planned driveway from Apex BBQ Road into our property. But because of some changes in the driveway, the entry road will now be Magdala Place and the church address will be 725 Magdala Place. Magdala is the hometown of Mary Magdalene in the Holy Land.

I trust you know that any funds over our BAA goal come back to the parish. This past week we received the overage check from the 2015 BAA - \$ 45,567.03. You do not need to guess where we put those funds!

In regard to the current 2016 BAA. We now have received \$160,069 from 497 families. That is 86% of our goal of \$186,555 from 30% of our parish members. I am hopeful this weekend we will go over goal. We would be delighted to hear from all members so a year from now we also receive a good overage check when we are getting close to finishing the church construction.

We will contact all those folks we have not yet heard from - our real goal is 100% participation. Pastors have known forever that a personal contact is the most effective way to ask for funds. Perhaps I can ask those who gave already to take 2 names and visit those homes. Maybe someday in the future we can send a drone instead of a volunteer.
