Members of the Parish,

On this Memorial Day weekend we offer thanks to all those who served our country, especially during times of war. We are grateful and we pray for those who serve now in dangerous and faraway places. May God protect them and may the efforts of our political leaders bring peace to our world.

#### Chapel

Here is a picture of our proposed Chapel looking toward the altar [not pictured]. The line of windows are pieces of the large stained glass we will have in the church. Also there is a window of St Mary Magdalene on another wall.

The other picture is a rendition of the inside of the church.

We continue to ask members of our parish who have not yet made a pledge or gift to the new church to do so now. We have particular need to complete the Chapel and some other items we have had to defer. You gift will be a big help in this time of our need and your opportunity. A pledge of \$5,000 payable over 4 years will be a huge help to our parish.







#### **Bishop's Annual Appeal**

A word about the Bishop's Annual Appeal. We achieved our parish goal in February - many thanks to those who gave. The Diocese has not yet reached the total goal, but probably will this week or next week. I am grateful to members of StMM who made it possible for us to conclude this work so early.

#### **Memory Wall**

About our new church - in the next month or so we are going to begin a Memory Wall on the bulletin board in the lobby. This is a delicate task, and it will take some weeks to complete. All those who have given so far at the \$5,000 level and higher will be acknowledged. We hope this acknowledgment is encouraging to others to begin contributing to our building task. The real Memory Wall in the church will not be exactly like the one in the lobby.

#### Census

Spring cleaning - our parish is obliged to report accurate census data in July of each year. We search our memories and files in our large [1600 households] parish to try to see who is here - or rather who is not here.

For those we cannot find - usually a check of contribution records helps us - we will soon send a letter. If we do not receive a response, we move people to an inactive file. When we do the annual census, we often cannot find information for about 150 households.

## Weddings

I have had requests/inquiries now for 4 weddings in the new church. But the church has to be completed first. I have told couples that the earliest we can make arrangements is after July 1, 2017; that is a date I feel safe about, and will not require moving the wedding to the gym at the last minute. Would not that be an excitement!!

Until now we have depended on the generosity of other nearby parishes for weddings. I am grateful for their helpfulness, especially St Andrew, St Michael, and Sacred Heart Cathedral. Now we will have to develop this ministry for ourselves.
