# Parking for Easter Sunday Outdoor Masses

### **GENERAL INFORMATION** -

- Please bring your own chairs for the outdoor Masses at 9am and 11am
- The Parking lot behind the church will be closed off for seating.
- No Live stream of the Easter Morning Masses.
- The recorded Saturday Easter Vigil Mass can be viewed Easter Sunday from our YouTube channel "STMM Church Live". <u>Click here for link to channel</u>.
- We ask those attending the 11am Mass, to arrive after 1040am, to allow for the flow of vehicles and parishioners from the 9am Mass to be able to depart the campus.
- We will be using the sports field for parking of vehicles and parishioners will need to walk down the sidewalk to the rear of the Church to sit for the Mass.
- Handicapped persons are encouraged to come to the drive thru communion behind the school.

### ARRIVING ON CAMPUS-

- Please use the Townside Drive entry to campus.
- The Apex BBQ Road entry will be used for exit only.
- Parking Attendants will guide you to available parking locations in the school lot or onto the sports fields.

### DEPARTING FROM CAMPUS-

- After conclusion of Mass, please return to your vehicle and follow guidance from parking attendants.
- The road onto Apex BBQ Road will be used to EXIT the campus after Mass.

### OUTDOOR COMMUNION (after 9am Mass)

- Will be held BEHIND the School.
- Please use the Village Commons Lane (road behind the school) to enter the rear parking lot.
- Eucharistic Ministers will provide communion to parishioners into your car.
- No parking will be available in the rear lot.
- A drive through loop in the rear parking lot will be utilized for communion to smooth the process.
