

### April is National Child Abuse Prevention Month



Did you know that the Diocese of Raleigh requires that all people who work or volunteer with children and youth in our parishes and schools attend a training in how to recognize and report child abuse? The training details five steps to prevent child sexual abuse:

- 1. Knowing the warning signs of abuse.
- 2. Reporting suspected abuse to appropriate authorities.
- Controlling access to children by carefully selecting the adults who work with children and youth.
- 4. Monitoring all programs for the safety of children and youth.
- 5. Awareness of and sensitive to the lives of children.

April is national Prevent Child Abuse month. Please know that we are diligently working to provide safe environments for children.




