A Lenten Night of Reflection with Fr. Scott McCue March 10, 7 PM Church Live Stream Link

Our Lenten night of reflection will look at three key gospel passages from John that served as moments of transformation:

The Woman at the Well "Whoever drinks the water I shall give will never thirst" The Man Born Blind "I am the light of the world" The Raising of Lazarus "Untie him and let him go."

Fr. Scott will help us to understand how these passages transformed those who Jesus encountered and how they can help in our ongoing transformation as disciples.



A priest of the Dicoese of Raleigh for 20 years, Fr. Scott serves as Pastor of St. Thomas More in Chapel Hill. Previously has has served as Pastor of St. Ann in Clayton and Asst. Principal for Spiritual Life at Cardinal Gibbons High School. Fr. Scott currently also serves as Dean of the Piedmont Deanery, a member of the Council of Priests, the College of Consultors and as Diocesan Scout Chaplain.


Brick Orders


