Elementary Faith Formation

First Reconciliation & First Eucharist

Sacramental preparation is a two-year process in the Diocese of Raleigh. Children who plan to receive their sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist in the second grade, need to be enrolled in GATHER in the first grade. The KofC are putting together bags with a list of food items in them. There will be tubs located under the drive through portico on the chapel side of the church starting Monday until Thursday of each week. One tub will be labeled "Completed bags" and the other will be labeled "Bag items". If you cannot fill an entire bag, please just give what you can and we'll put bags together out of whatever we collect. This allows for a 'no contact' way to help out during this difficult time.

Here are the items for one completed bag:

- · 1 Rice or dried beans
- · 1 Pasta & 1 Small Canned Sauce
- · 1 Boxed Meal (hamburger helper or Mac-N-Cheese)
- · 1 Canned Vegetable
- · 1 Canned Fruit
- · 6 Snack Items (individually wrapped)
- · 1 Breakfast Items
- · 1 Hygiene Item
- · 1 Roll of Toilet Paper

Please bag these items at home and only include "like" items from above. We are not able to date check the donations, so please fill these bags with in-date items we can hand directly to folks in need. Please make sure everything fits into ONE bag which can be double knotted!


2020 Parish Survey Results - Installment 2 of 4

Thank you to everyone who participated in or assisted with the 2020 Parish Survey which was conducted

in the spring of this year. We received a fantastic response from 211 members of the Parish! We'd like to share some of the results with you over the course of the month of September, and tell you more about what we'll be doing with this data. Please note that the data collected and presented here is only a sample of the parish.

- Respondents who provided their contact information and expressed interest in a particular adult ministry have been contacted by the respective leaders of that ministry.
- A summary of the data specific to current members and parishioners interested in each existing adult ministry has been shared with the ministry leaders.
- The survey data has been shared with Father Chris and the Parish Council.
- During the fall, please keep your eyes out for excerpts in the weekly ENews and brief
 presentations during Mass highlighting individual adult ministries and how you can stay involved
 during the pandemic.
- Once we're able to gather in person again, we'll be looking at starting new adult ministries based on suggestions provided by the survey respondents.

Please see below for installment 2 of 4 of the survey data summary which focuses on survey respondents' most frequent Mass to attend:



^{*}For those interested in participating in evangelization adult ministries, the Sunday 6:00 p.m. Mass is the most popular mass to attend.

- 19-25 years old: Sunday 10:45 a.m. (50% of age group)
- 26-35 years old: Sunday 9:00 a.m. (54% of age group)
- 36-45 years old: Sunday 10:45 a.m. (38% of age group) or Sunday 9:00 a.m. (36% of age group)
- 46-55 years old: Sunday 6:00 p.m. (34% of age group)
- 56-65 years old: Sunday 5:00 p.m. (39 % of age group)
- 66-75 years old: Sunday 9:00 a.m. (35% of age group)
- 75+ years old: Sunday 9:00 a.m. (44% of age group)

Most popular Mass by age of parishioners' children

- Parishioners with pre-school or elementary aged children are most likely to attend the Sunday 9:00 a.m. or Sunday 10:45 a.m. Mass.
- Parishioners with middle school aged children are most likely to attend the Sunday 10:45 a.m. or Sunday 6:00 p.m. Mass.
- Parishioners with high school aged children are most likely to attend the Sunday 6:00 p.m. Mass.
- Parishioners with adult children are most likely to attend the Saturday 5:00 p.m. Mass


