Our Columbarium



The masonry work on the columbarium is close to completion. Later this month the flooring is scheduled be installed. That will be followed by a mid-June installation of the stainless steel niche structures. The columbarium is on schedule to be completed in time for the Church dedication on July 15, 2017. We are preparing to start inurnments in August of 2017.

In our information series over the last few weeks, we indicated an update on the availability of a preferred urn. In conjunction with Apex Funeral Home, two avenues of discounted urn pricing are being made available for a limited amount of time. Between now and Dec 31, 2017, you can purchase the StMM preferred urn at a significant discount off retail prices. This deal is made available ONLY through an online purchase; please go to <u>www.STMM.church/welcome</u>

<u>/columbarium.cfm</u> to review the urn guideline document and complete your urn purchase. Once complete, you may immediately pick up your urn(s) at Apex Funeral Home. When using this option, you are under no obligation to use services through Apex Funeral Home at the time of death or inurnment.

The second avenue is to complete a pre-arrangement agreement with Apex Funeral Home. Between now and Sept 1, 2017, Apex Funeral is offering the same preferred urn at no cost to those who pre-arrange service. The pre-arrangement process will include an informational seminar provided by Apex Funeral Home and StMM. An invitation to attend a seminar will come out in the bulletin in the next few weeks.

If you have plans on making a columbarium reservation in 2017, we respectfully request you do that as early as possible to help offset construction costs.
