The goal is \$191,507. We will pass pledge forms around at the beginning of the sermon. You can fill them in today and place them in the basket or bring them back next weekend.


Using time-tested parish formulas we can make our goal easily if every parish family considers a gift of \$187, payable over six months. Larger gifts are most welcome.
