On Holy Thursday we have the ceremony of the Washing of Feet as Jesus did for his 12 Apostles at the Last Supper. If you would like to volunteer to participate in this service, please tell me after Mass or by email. All are welcome from the 3rd grade up.

Keep in mind we do not have Baptisms during Lent but I welcome babies for baptism for the Easter Sunday Masses and for the Masses July 16, the Sunday after new church Dedication.

Last week we received \$4,325 in the 2nd collection for Catholic Relief Services. Thank you very much.


