This weekend we welcome Father Peter Quinto to our parish for the annual collection for Missions. Each parish in our Diocese is assigned one weekend for a collection for the Missions. Father will speak about the ministry and mission work of the Rogationist Fathers.

I congratulate the young people of our parish who received the Sacrament of Confirmation on Friday evening.

It was a pleasure for me to be the one who confirmed since we do not yet have a Bishop. I never confirmed a class before, and I expect that opportunity will not come again - presuming we do not have a Bishop vacancy again.

To repeat what I wrote last week: Pastors normally confer Confirmation at the Easter vigil for the RCIA people, but pastors in our Diocese this year may confirm since we do not have a Bishop. If we do not have a new Bishop in the next week or so, my guess is we will not have one until after the Dedication of the new Cathedral. It is a guess - I have no inside information.
