
There will be two stations available outside in the drive thru at the portico for communion following the 9:00 am Mass for those at-risk and those receiving gluten free hosts.




Thanks to all the families who attended our opening night Mass with Fr. Chris. What a blessing to be back worshiping together!

# St. Thomas More/UNC Newman Spiritual Direction Ministry

The St. Thomas More/UNC Newman Spiritual Direction Ministry is offering the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius this Fall. Called a retreat in everyday life, the 30-week program is an excellent alternative for people unable to do a traditional 30-day retreat.

The Exercises will be offered on Wednesdays from 5:30 pm to 7 pm in person on St. Thomas More's South Campus and via Zoom at the same time. The program begins October 13, 2021 and finishes May 25, 2022. The program will enroll 20 people (four groups of five people) and does not meet during Thanksgiving, Christmas and Easter holidays.

Through this prayer journey using biblical meditation and other Ignatian spiritual practices, you will deepen your relationship with Jesus and prayerfully discern his call to you at this time in your life. You will be asked to pray and reflect 30-60 minutes a day and to share reflections each week in your small group.

Past participants have found the Exercises to be a powerful journey into spiritual growth and a closer relationship with God. The cost of the program is \$450--a \$50 registration payment and the balance in one or two payments.
