#### A Note From Father Donald Staib

Thank you for the wonderful generosity last weekend in the 2nd collection for those harmed by Hurricane Harvey in Texas. We received \$13,787, one of the largest 2nd collections in memory. These funds will be distributed through Catholic Charities in the Dioceses that have been impacted. In addition our StMM school community has collected boxes of supplies and over \$6,500 for StMM school in Humble, Texas.

Also - commendation to all who organized and volunteered in our Ministry Fair last weekend. It was our first use of the lobby and I thought it served our parish well.

This coming week all priests of the Diocese will be on Retreat. There will be morning Mass only on Monday. As always we remember members of our parish at Mass during the Retreat days. This will be the first opportunity for me to be with our new Bishop, but he will also have to meet over 100 other priests during the week. That would exhaust my memory.

Next week we will have a  $2^{nd}$  collection for those who have lost everything in the devastation of Hurricane Irma.

From the Introduction to the Book of Sirach: The author, a sage who lived in Jerusalem, was thoroughly imbued with love for the law, the priesthood, the temple, and divine worship. As a wise and experienced observer of life he addressed himself to his contemporaries with the motive of helping them to maintain religious faith and integrity through study of the holy books, and through tradition.

Another sage I have learned about -- Wu Yubi, a Chinese scholar and teacher of the 1400's, wrote: My goal is to progress to the point of mastering myself by devoting myself to the cultivation of reverence and empathy. The reason I know about Wu is that a high school student I taught long ago translated his diaries and memoirs. I am in awe of that kind of talent. And impressed by sages of any age, even though their relentless searches will always remain searches.
