Holy Week begins on Palm Sunday. None of us have remembered Jesus' death and Resurrection as we will this year. There is much to pray for and many people who are suffering in the present circumstances. We keep in prayer the sick and those who care for them, for those whose jobs are in jeopardy, for our children who have to find new ways to be at school. May all our communities soon come together again.

Here is our very abridged church schedule this week.

Live streamed Mass on Palm Sunday at 10:45. There will be Palms on the brick bench at the drive thru on the south side of the church. They will be in plastic wrappings and you are welcome to come for some on your way to groceries or other necessary trips. We will put them out around 10 am Sunday and leave them there all day.

Holy Thursday Mass will be live-steamed at 7 pm. I will miss the Foot Washing part of Holy Thursday. It is always a reminder of our service to one another.

On Good Friday there will be Stations of the Cross at noon and there will be a reflection on Jesus' 7 Last Words at 3 pm.

On Easter Sunday live streamed Mass will be at 10:45.


We have been advised not to have Confessions during this time.

**BAPTISMS** - See the Guidelines on the Website - then email the Pastor. First time parents must attend a baptism class [a good time is during the 9 months prior to birth.] Baptisms are usually, not always, at 10am on Saturdays or at weekend Masses.

**CONFESSIONS** - Always check the Pastor's Paragraph in the weekly Bulletin or our E-News mailed on Fridays. Confessions are usually, but not every week, at 10:30am on Saturdays in the Church.

WEDDINGS - See the Guidelines on the Website - then email the Pastor.




