

At StMM, we are following the continuing updated recommendations from the CDC during this virus outbreak

- All Daily and Weekend Masses have been cancelled till further notice (March 17, 2020 communication)
 - Bishop has provided his release from the obligation to attend Mass (March 12, 2020 communication)
- School is closed till end of March 2020 per order of Governor and Bishop (March 14, 2020 communication)
 - All groups, programs, classes, field trips and organizations have ceased at this time
- K of C Fish Fry on March 20th has been cancelled.

- Out of an abundance of caution, and following the advice of Federal and State Health authorities, we are working to limit gatherings in other settings besides Mass.
- At this time, All Daily and Weekend Masses are cancelled.
 - We ask anyone who is ill, to remain at home and contact via phone their health team for evaluation and guidance
 - Those high risk, vulnerable populations (older adults > 60 yrs; those with serious heart, respiratory conditions or diabetes) should avoid crowds to limit exposure
