

The pricing includes a niche suitable for two urns, the engraving of the granite faceplate, opening and closing cost, and the perpetual care of Our Columbarium. The price does not include the cost of the urns, changes in inscription requiring a replacement faceplate or any other funeral expenses. Full payment is required at the time of contract signing.

Part of the St. Mary Magdalene campus is a Columbarium made up of 552 niches each designed to hold two urns. All the niches in the Columbarium are exactly the same, and are there to provide eternal care of cremated remains of a deceased loved one. Our Columbarium is located right next to the Church and provides an area conducive to privacy, reflection, and prayer.

The cremated remains of the body are to be treated with the same respect given to the human body from which they came. The reverent disposition of the cremated remains in Our Columbarium meets all the requirements of the Catholic Church.

Our Columbarium is intended primarily for the parishioners of St. Mary Magdalene Catholic Church and their families. Any registered member of the parish may purchase a niche at parishioner pricing for themselves as well as family members who are not parishioners. Family members are defined as spouse, parents, grandparents, siblings, children and grandchildren of the parishioner. The Pastor will approve any special circumstances.
