Sacramental Prep for Teens Off Cycle

For teens who are off cycle for their sacraments and are seeking to receive First Reconciliation and/or First Eucharist in 7th/8th grade the sacramental guidelines in the Diocese of Raleigh and St. Mary Magdalene parish are below.

1) All sacramental preparation for First Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation in the Diocese of Raleigh are a 2 year process which must be completed over 2 consecutive years of regularly attending a Catholic parish faith formation in addition to sacramental prep sessions during year 2.

2) <u>To receive First Reconciliation & First Communion in 7th or 8th grade:</u>

- Teen must have completed Year 1 by regularly attending & completing a Catholic Faith Formation program at a Catholic parish/St. Mary Magdalene during their 6th or 7th grade school year.
- Teen must complete Year 2 by regularly attending & completing a Catholic Faith Formation program at a Catholic parish/St. Mary Magdalene during their 7th or 8th grade school year.
- In addition, they must complete 5 sacramental prep sessions held at St Mary Magdalene during their Year 2 of preparation. Dates TBA
- Year 1 and Year 2 must be done consecutively with no gap year(s) in between

3) To receive First Reconciliation & First Communion in 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th grade:

- Teen must have completed Year 1 by regularly attending & completing a Catholic Faith Formation program at a Catholic parish/St. Mary Magdalene during their 8th/9th/10th/11th grade school year.
- Teen must complete Year 2 by regularly attending & completing a Catholic Faith Formation program at a Catholic parish/St. Mary Magdalene during their 9th/10th/11th/12th grade school year.
- In addition, they must complete 5 sacramental prep sessions. Teens will be matched with sacramental mentors and set up dates/times to meet.
- Year 1 and Year 2 must be done consecutively with no gap year(s) in between
