BIBLICAL 40 DAYS

Traditionally, we know the 40 days of Lent primarily as the penitential season in which also we are encouraged to do intensive prayer, giving alms and practice self-mortification-fasting as we join Jesus in the desert.

Allow me to take you through the many other occasions in the bible where forty days are referred to and with varying effects, for a deeper appreciation and personal engagement. In Gen 7:4-8:, we read about the 40 days of the flood (destroyed sin but along with life, only Noah's family and a representation of creation was saved), Exodus 24:18/34:28, Moses was on Mount Sinai forty days and forty nights not eating any bread or drinking any water before receiving the Decalogue (preparing), Numbers 13:25, the Israelite spies returned after 40 days of spying Canaan land (working with hope), 1 Kings 19:8, Elijah travelled 40 days and forty nights to Horeb the Mount of God (running to rescue his life from evil), in Deut 8:2-5 the Lord God led the Israelites for forty years through the wilderness to humble them and test them if they could keep the commandment of God, in Matthew 4:1-11 Jesus was led into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil,(won for you and for me). In Acts 1:3 forty days and nights passed between Christs' resurrection and ascension (complete transformation and restoration) and the list can go on and on.

Dear reader, you might have acknowledged that the forty days in the bible take different shapes, to mention but not limited to preparation, testing (including destruction) transformation and restoration. All these generally challenge us to rely on God for worse for better, we are called to draw closer to God, to strengthen our relationship with Him through prayer for physical and spiritual nourishment.

I invite you my brother/sister to take a moment of introspection and reflect upon your personal life and in line with the commandment of love in its double dimension. I wish you the very best of this Lent. Lord God, let this Lent be a life transforming period in my life and the world around me. Amen




