

A NOTE FROM FATHER FRANCIS

MY FAMILY, A PIVOT

A family is like a proverbial Barkcloth tree/ficus natalensis [mutuba or omutoma], this tree like most of the tropical trees can manage to survive in the shallow, nutrient-poor soils by using its buttress roots which are often vulnerable as some are above the surface. It also spreads these shallow extensive root mats to absorb quickly decaying surface nutrients as well as keeping it anchored and stable. When grown fully, it provides shade and fodder for livestock and agriculture textile production without decaying. Despite its vulnerability, it is very creative and eco-friendly.

No worries, I'm not a botanical student, but guess what! When a child was born from home [including myself] the after birth/placenta would be honored and respectfully be buried under the Barkcloth tree, wow! And this practice, symbolically was a reminder that this is your cradle and so for good or for worse home is home. Equally, that the family counts on your sacrifices for its strength and your team work like the buttress roots to overcome the test of the time. Traditionally, the afterbirth preceded us to the ground so there is our grave yard assured.

In the same vein, as you know the placenta acts as a baby's life support system in the womb- doing work of the lungs, liver, kidney,and building the baby's immunity before birth, so it is my work to build and sustain our family.

Our weaknesses, differences and any challenges and frustrations as a family should be surmounted and meanwhile, our team work and self-sacrifices, will always remain the family pivot.

Thank you to every one for making a difference in my life and for your joyful spirits.

May the good God guide your steps, strengthen you in spirit, heal those sick and comfort the afflicted.
