We are reminded that God has good things planned for those who love Him. These blessings are not always easy to see, yet the Holy Spirit can help us to understand them. God's wisdom is not like the world's, for His wisdom leads to real joy and peace.

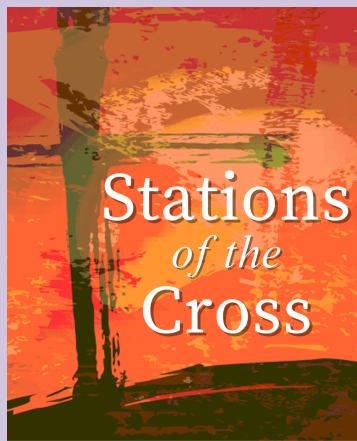

Cardinal Gibbons High School is leading the development of a **new Catholic high school** in the Raleigh, North Carolina area, set to open in the fall of 2028.

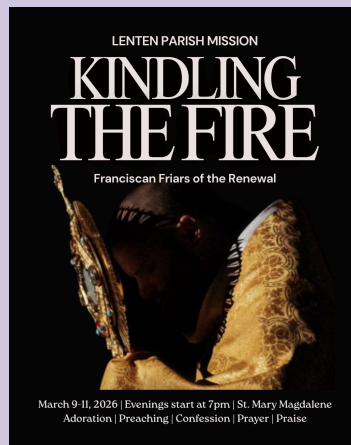

StMM Lenten Activities



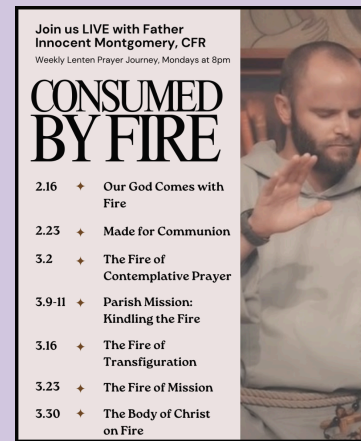
For Catholics worldwide, the Stations of the Cross is a popular Lenten devotion, also called the "Way of the Cross." It is a prayerful meditation on the final hours of Jesus' life.

Beginning February 20, Stations of the Cross will be held in the main Church every Friday during Lent, immediately after the 9am Mass and again at 7pm. Everyone is welcome!



Our St. Mary Magdalene Lenten Parish Mission, *Kindling the Fire*, will be led by the Franciscan Friars of the Renewal **March 9–11**, beginning at 7pm each evening. Each night will include adoration, preaching, prayer, confession, and praise.
