

A Note from Seminarian Juan Fernando

Pilgriming with Faith and Hope: An Encounter with the Living Church

In our lives, we all experience moments when our faith is tested — moments when we reaffirm what we believe, or when we simply feel God's presence in a powerful way. This, I believe, is the best way to summarize the past three weeks I spent with my mother as pilgrims during this Jubilee Year. I don't want to miss the opportunity to share with you, my dear brothers and sisters of STMM, some reflections and important moments from our pilgrimage to Rome in search of that hope Pope Francis invited us to embrace when he opened the Holy Door last December — a hope that His Holiness Pope Leo has now renewed with the same call.

Before reaching Rome, I had the blessing of attending Sunday Mass at Notre Dame in Paris, and just a few days later traveling to Lourdes to entrust the Jubilee of Young People to Our Lady. The presence of the Blessed Virgin accompanied us every step of the way, and I carried each of you in my prayers.

When we arrived in Rome, along with more than a million other young people, I discovered that right in front of my hotel there was a church housing a relic of Saint Mary Magdalene — her foot. In that moment, I felt the Lord speaking to my heart, reminding me that even though I was thousands of miles away from my StMM community, you were always close in prayer — as I was praying for you.

At the Mass for young people, I could not hold back my tears as together, over a million of us proclaimed our faith: One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic — under the guidance of Peter, today Pope Leon XIV. Seeing the Pope, his warm smile, and receiving his blessing was one of the greatest moments I will forever treasure in my heart. While the world may sometimes tell us that the Church is dying or that there are no young people left in it, this experience showed me that the opposite is true: the Church is more alive than ever! It speaks hundreds of languages, proclaims Christ as alive, and above all, speaks the language of Love — because God is Love (Deus Caritas Est). I didn't need to know anyone beforehand to feel them as my brothers and sisters, nor did I need to pass through the Holy Door to know that I was home.

Throughout this journey, I kept you in my prayers, knowing that you are my family, my friends, and most of all, my Church. I return renewed, convinced that the mission lies ahead — that Christ, more than ever, is calling me to believe, to serve Him in my brothers and sisters, and to give myself completely.

I send you the warm and loving greeting of Pope Leo.

Please keep me in your prayers.
