FRIENDSHIP AND RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD

Just created for a relationship or more than that, I'm just wondering!!! In my mother tongue, friendship is **OBUNYWANI/KUNYWANA**, and it refers to a bond of connectedness, intentionally built on trust and mutual respect between two individuals. We also use **obunywani** referenced as **veins** (blood vessels) purposefully knotted, or for mutual support like the case of the **rib cage**. Whereas **relationship** is an automatic connection resulting from the very creatural nature of man/woman. And thus, man (being with physical body, life, and force) vertically relates with the Creator, and horizontally with others (no choice needed).

Carrying from the above, we see that by nature we are relational beings, and as such, our existence, identity, growth, development, and influence is compulsorily with others. However, the quality of this relationship is determined by the way we treat ourselves and/or others.

Relatedly, my question: Is it satisfactorily enough to be in relationship with God and/or others, or is there need to strive for friendship?

As far as the Bible is concerned, choice is the bedrock on which friendship with God is built: "but to you, Israel, my servant, Jacob whom I have chosen, the offspring of Abraham my friend..." (Is 41:8), and requires faith, trust, and obedience. James 2:23: "...Abraham believed God, and it was reckoned to him as righteousness, and was called the friend of God," just like in John 15:15, Christ chose and called His disciples friends.

By enduring faith and obedience, I see, we too can be chosen to be God's friends. We can intentionally also choose friends among ourselves who will purposefully walk side by side with us, or who can pave the way for our destiny.

I pray for you to move from casual relationships to meaningful friendship in our journey of faith.
