A Note from Father Mike

St. Mary 🖁 Magdalene

This weekend we celebrate one of the great saints, a woman who, after the Blessed Virgin, is mentioned most in the Gospels. We remember and celebrate St. Mary Magdalene in a special way. She is our patron of our parish, a witness to the transforming power of Divine Mercy, and a model of the indispensable service and dignity of women in the Church. Mary Magdalene had been forgiven by the Lord, and was given the grace to experience who she really was and how much she was loved. She knew she had been saved and healed by God.

That is an experience all of us should begin with, if we are going to imitate the lives of the saints. After she received God's mercy, she was one of several women who faithfully accompanied Jesus and the apostles during their journeys and provided for them out of their resources. Mary Magdalene was faithful to her savior to the end, standing at the foot of the Cross together with the Blessed Mother and other women. We see in the Gospel this weekend that early on Easter morning, the first moment she could, she came to the tomb in order to anoint Jesus' lifeless body. She was seeking him. She was lost without his guidance. She loved her savior so much that she wanted to be with him, even if it would just be near his lifeless body.

Burning with the fire of love, Mary Magdalene longed for him whom she thought had been taken away. And so it happened that the woman who stayed behind to seek Christ was the only one to see him. For perseverance is essential to any good deed, as the voice of truth tells us, "Whoever perseveres to the end will be saved."

We can see in Mary Magdalene's life that God did some amazing things in her and through her life. This happened because she loved with all her heart. As St. Paul tells us in 1 Corinthians, "No eye has seen, nor ear heard, nor the human heart conceived, what God has prepared for those who love him." When we hear this passage, we may think it is just a description of what we will experience in heaven. Yet, I believe it can also describe what God can do in our lives and through our lives when we love him with all our heart.
