

A Note from Father Mike

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi. We also come together to celebrate the depths of our Lord's love for us, which has led Him to stay with us. In this weekend's Gospel acclamation, we hear Jesus say, *"I am the living bread that came down from heaven... whoever eats this bread will live forever."* We all probably remember the feeding of the 5000 in the Gospel of John. Jesus does this to teach the powerful truth about God's plan of salvation for mankind and to help show His heavenly origin.

Jesus graciously fed a great multitude of hungry people with five small barley loaves and two small fish, but the truth He wanted everyone to know was far deeper. He was showing us that earthly food will only satisfy our physical needs temporarily, and that He had come down from heaven to provide us with heavenly food that would satisfy our spiritual needs. Our Lord came to make it crystal clear that HE is the spiritual nourishment that we need.

When God speaks to us, it is important that we listen. Our Lord Jesus wants everyone to understand that HE is the Father's divine gift to humanity and that only through believing in Him, would mankind find eternal life. Surely this truth should make our heart rejoice through time and into eternity. It should prompt us to share this truth with the next generation and to all who will listen.

Let us always give thanks for the "*Real Presence*" of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist. When we follow our Lord's teachings and receive His precious Body and Blood, we will live forever. May we never forget the sacrifice our Lord has made for us, so that we may have eternal life. We should be forever grateful to our Heavenly Father for sending His precious Son to redeem mankind, to feed us spiritually, and to lead us to our heavenly home.
