

### A Note from Father Francis

NEW POPE- WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

In the last E-news note, I invited you to pray for the new pontiff; now, we thank God for His gift of Pope Leo XIV.

Today I'm interested in how to have this papacy present here/there in our family and community. First and foremost, the Pope alone, without you, cannot bring about the Church Christ wants. The Dogmatic Constitution on the Church (LUMEN GENTIUM) articulates that the Pope, together with the bishops in communion, hold the teaching authority of the Church (the magisterium), and they have authority to teach, interpret, and safeguard the Church's teachings. However, needless to say, by virtue of our baptism and confirmation, "you (the church) are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's own people, in order that you may proclaim the mighty acts of Him......" (1 Pt. 2:9). This means the magisterium (papacy) is incomplete without the laity who are called in their vocations and professions to respond to and live in faith and actions the teachings of Christ.

More so, because you form the biggest percentage of the Church, after accepting guidance from Church teachings and applying it in the secular world, you are expected to enlighten the magisterium by making your views on matters concerning the good of the Church.

We are urged to observe the command structure of the Church and also not to be mean in our action and responsibility in strengthening the teaching office of the church that the Pope presides over. It is also important to note, the Pope will not have much to offer without bishops, and together with the bishops have no meaningful magisterium without you, the laity, from whom they are chosen and who they represent and serve, as well as who further the teaching in the secular world by direct involvement.

Pray, lastly, that as a Church, the body of Christ, sharing in the gifts of the Holy Spirit and in the authority of Christ the Head, we will keep the unity of the Church by strengthening the magisterium and witness to Christ.
