

## A Note from Father Francis

#### PRAY FOR A NEW POPE;

Many people are very anxious about the next Pope. The Church calls us to pray as our part in participating in the realization of a new Pope, after the heart of Jesus, the true shepherd of his people.

I therefore extend an invitation to each one of us to pray using the fourfold model of St. Catherine of Siena: a prayer for herself (personal conversion), for the reformation of the church, for the whole world - especially for peace among Christians- and for Divine Providence.

St. Catherine of Siena believed that while the nature and character of the Pope matter, a call to personal conversion is central to every Christian's call and vocation in the prophetic mission and reformation of the Church. She observed that the baptized form one mystical body of Christ with many diverse gifts and responsibilities. She also acknowledged that the love of God is impossible without the love of neighbor, and hence a universal call for conversion and courage on the part of the Popes, politicians, political leaders, and everybody.

Friends, the Church, being a rock as Christ willed it (cf. Mt 16:18), is not the effect of experiences or changes in people (Popes keep changing), neither is it an expression of psychological needs, cultural situations at any given time, or mere subjectivity. St. Catherine of Siena encourages us to participate by praying. We should pray more earnestly that the Church remains unshakable in her distinctive role as the dispenser of the objective truth from God for the good of man/woman and societal conscience.

Holy God release your Spirit of truth upon the conclave for the continuity of your Church and for the salvation of human kind.

God is good.
